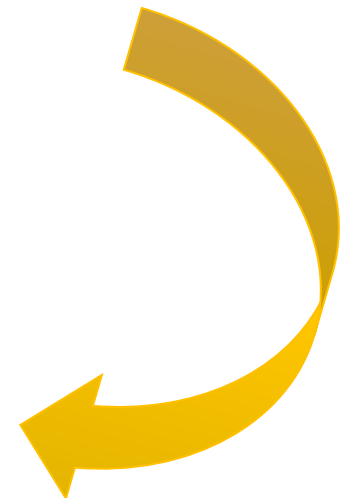
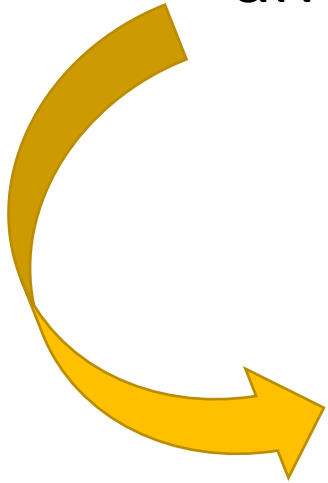

Semester 1: Fall, First Year

- ❖ Take Diversity elective (if not taken already)
- ❖ Prepare for Communication and Literacy Skills MTEL

Summer:

- ❖ Take and pass Communication and Literacy Skills MTEL
- ❖ Get experience working with children

Semester 3: Fall, Sophomore

- ❖ Finish any remaining prerequisites courses
- ❖ Continue GenEds
- ❖ Take and pass MTEL (if not done so already)
- ❖ Prepare application materials

Winter/Semester 4: Spring, Sophomore

- ❖ **Apply in January**
- ❖ Finish GenEds
- ❖ Take EDUC elective(s)
